MAINTENANCE PLAN

According to UNI EN 1176/2017 it requires the following maintenance plan:



- Visual routine inspection

Allows you to identify obvious hazards that may result from vandalism, use or atmospheric effects, you can then find damaged or dirt/hazardous waste for the safety of children. Then proceed to the repair/replacement of any elements of the game and the cleaning (use non-aggressive products). Depending on the frequency of use of the structure you can get to also request a daily inspection by such employees of the municipality or by any teachers.

- Operational inspection

It 'a thorough and detailed examination to verify the status of use, stability and wear of the game. Based on the materials used for the construction recommend a 3 months inspection cycle (maximum cycle according to the legislation)

- Annual Main Inspection

control of the overall level of safety of the structure in order to detect the effects of atmospheric agents, corrosion of the surfaces or other possible variations of the level of security.

The checks on monthly and yearly operational inspection can be summarized as follows:

- Tightening of the fasteners;
- Check the presence of all the nut covers;
- Maintenance of any energy absorbing surfaces;
- Cleaning;
- Removal of waste or hazardous materials inside or in the perimeter of the structure;
- Adding or loose filling material to the correct level;
- Verification of compliance or of the free and maintenance.
